He said to him, "Go and marry a prostitute...so that some of her children will be conceived in prostitution. ²So Hosea married Gomer... Hosea 1:2b, 3a (NLT)

Player 5. Hosea's Son _____ – God _____.

... she became pregnant and gave Hosea a son. ⁴ And the LORD said, "Name the child Jezeel, for I am about to punish King Jehu's dynasty to avenge the murders he committed at Jezreel. In fact, I will bring an end to Israel's independence. ⁵ I will break its military power in the Jezreel Valley." Hosea 1:3b-5 (NLT)

After Gomer had weaned Lo-ruhamah, she again became pregnant and gave birth to a second son. ⁹ And the LORD said, "Name him Lo-ammi—'Not My people'—for Israel is not My people, and I am not their God. Hosea 1:8, 9 (NLT)
