1. MY DEATH IS

Since the children are made of flesh and blood, it's logical that the Savior took on flesh and blood in order to rescue them by his death. By embracing death, taking it into himself, he destroyed the Devil's hold on death and freed all who cower through life, scared to death of death. **Hebrews 2:14, 15** (MP)

Who got the last word, oh, Death? Oh, Death, who's afraid of you now? ⁵⁶ It was sin that made death so frightening and law-code guilt that gave sin its leverage, its destructive power. ⁵⁷ But now in a single victorious stroke of Life, all three--sin, guilt, death--are gone, the gift of our Master, Jesus Christ. Thank God! 1 Corinthians 15:55-57 (MP)

Since have died to sin, how can we continue to live in it? ³ Or have you forgotten that when we were joined with Christ Jesus in baptism, we joined Him in His death? ⁴For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism. And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives. ⁵ Since we have been united with Him in His death, we will also be raised to life as He was. ⁶ We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives.
