*“My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?” **Matthew 27:46** NIV*

*Yet you brought me out of the womb; you made me trust in you, even at my mother's breast. **Psalm 22:1** NIV*

*From birth I was cast on you; from my mother's womb you have been my God. **Psalm 22:10** NIV*

*Do not be far from me, for trouble is near and there is no one to help. **Psalm 22:11** NIV*

3. _____ MY _____ TO MY _____ GOD.

*“Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!” **Luke 23:46**, **Psalm 31:5** NIV*

*As they hurled stone after stone at him, Stephen prayed, “Our Lord Jesus, accept my spirit into your presence.”⁶⁰ He crumpled to his knees and shouted in a loud voice, “Our Lord, don't hold this sin against them.” And then he died. **Acts 7:59, 60** NLT*
